### **DECREES**

Students' enrolment in the restricted access **Cognitive Neuroscience** Master Degree Programme in English, class of the degree LM-51, for the 2020-2021 academic year, is subject to the participation in a procedure for the comparative assessment of qualifications.

### 1. Number of places available

The number of places available for EU citizens wherever they may reside and to non-EU citizens legally staying in Italy referred to in Article 26 of Law No. 189/2002, is equal to 20. The number of places available for non-EU citizens permanently resident abroad is equal to 20.

To apply for a study visa, following the provisions in force for the a.y. 2020-2021: https://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/, non-EU citizens permanently residing abroad who are applying for a visa, must apply on the **UNIVERSITALY platform** (https://www.universitaly.it/) and contact the **foreign students sector** "Hello-foreign students office" at the dedicated email: accesso.sapienza@uniroma1.it.

### 2. Admission requirements

**Non-EU citizens permanently resident abroad** and in possession of a study visa for the academic year 2020-2021 for "university registration" are admitted to the comparative assessment procedure if they satisfy the curricular requirements listed below or who submit a declaration in which they state they are going to earn the qualification required by September 15<sup>th</sup> 2020:

- Bachelor Degree in Psychology or a qualification earned abroad regarded as equivalent by the law in force;
- **B2** level English language certificate (ESOL, IELTS, TOEFL).

To apply for a study visa, following the provisions in force for the a.y. 2020-2021: https://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/, non-EU citizens permanently residing abroad who are applying for a visa, must apply on the **UNIVERSITALY platform** (https://www.universitaly.it/) and contact the **foreign students sector** "Hello-foreign students office" at the dedicated email: accesso.sapienza@uniroma1.it.

**Italian citizens, EU citizens wherever they reside and non-EU citizens legally residing in Italy** as per art. 26 of Law no. 189/2002 are admitted to the comparative assessment procedure if they hold the qualifications and satisfy the curricular requirements listed below or who submit a declaration in which they state they are going to earn the qualification required by **October 16**<sup>th</sup> **2020**:

- Bachelor Degree in Psychology or a 5-years Old University System Degree in Psychology or other qualifications earned abroad regarded as equivalent by the law in force;
- B2 level English language certificate (ESOL, IELTS, TOEFL).

Students who do not hold a language certificate will have to provide a self-certification of their knowledge of the English language upon application and attend an online/in presence interview to have their level of English assessed on **September 14 2020** at 10:00, if in presence in classroom X, second floor, via dei Marsi 78 – Roma.

## All the requirements listed above are an essential condition to enrol in the Master Degree Programme.

The University may in any case adopt exclusion or disqualification measures for candidates who, upon verification, turn out not to satisfy the requirements or who gave misleading statements.

## 3. Methods and deadlines for registering for the comparative assessment procedure

Registration for the benchmarking procedure is essential for **ALL** the applicants independently from their Country of residence, on **pain of exclusion**:

### a) Submit their application using the platform on:

https://www2.uniroma1.it/internazionale/incoming/, enclosing the documents listed below:

- a copy of their passport (pdf);
- a brief motivation letter;
- the original copy of their English language certificate (ESOL, IELTS o TOEFL) or a self-certification (EU citizens wherever they reside and non-EU citizens legally

residing in Italy, only). The English language certificate requirement does not apply to students who earned a bachelor degree in English;

- certification of the credits (ECTS/CFU) achieved in the previous degree programme (in original or by way of self-certification, if it is an Italian qualification, using the form in Attachment 2);
- graduation certificate (in original or by way of self-certification if it is an Italian qualification, using the form in Attachment 2);
- up to two reference letters (optional);

### b) Paying the € 35,00 registration fee.

Enrolment in the comparative evaluation procedure is subject to the payment of a **contribution of € 35.00** to be paid at any UniCredit Group branch in Italy starting from July 20<sup>th</sup> 2020 and in mandatory terms by September 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 indicating the <u>registration code</u> for the comparative assessment procedure: 29388.

To make the payment, you must only use the personalized form to be printed through the University's online information system (Infostud), according to the instructions on page https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/iscrizione-alle-prove-di-accesso-infostud.

Payment can also be made online, by credit card (for further information on payment methods consult the web page https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/come-pagare): on the due date, payment must be made online by 8.30 pm.

**Please Note:** keep the registration number issued by the Infostud system because it is essential for the other stages of the procedure.

On no account will the payment of the registration fee for the comparative assessment procedure be refunded.

**Attention**: Any communications will be sent to the e-mail address that has been given when registering on Infostud. We recommend that candidates check the address is correct. Students that are already registered on the Infostud system must check/enter their e-mail address using the function User data (dati utente) > change access data (modifica dati accesso).

The personalised form is at the same:

- self-certification of personal data;
- application for the comparative assessment procedure;
- payment slip for the registration fee.

Payments processed using different methods from those hereby described will not be accepted.

### 4. CANDIDATES WITH FOREIGN QUALIFICATIONS

Italian candidates, EU citizens, non-EU citizens legally residing in Italy and non-EU citizens permanently residing abroad, in possession of a foreign qualification, must follow all the procedures indicated in point 3 in order to register for the comparative assessment. Furthermore, it should be noted that non-EU citizens applying for a study visa, following the provisions in force for the a.y. 2020-2021: https://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/, must mandatorily prescribe on the UNIVERSITALY platform (https://www.universitaly.it/) and contact the foreign students sector "Hello-foreign students office" at the dedicated email: accesso.sapienza@uniroma1.it.

The winners in the ranking, in order to enrol, must necessarily go to the Hello - Foreign Students Sector within the prescribed deadlines to verify compliance and deliver the qualifications and documents required by the MUR circular. In compliance with the provisions issued by the competent authorities in relation to the Coronavirus Emergency, the registration procedures, such as: completion, presentation and administrative control of the compulsory documents will also be carried out electronically.

### 5. APPLICANTS' ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Once the admission requirements have been checked, the ranking will be prepared taking into account the criteria below:

- 1. weighted arithmetic mean based on the credits (ECTS/CFU) of the grades achieved in the exams of the Psychology field;
- 2. assessment of up to 2 reference letters drafted by Professors that had the chance to know the candidate during his/her university studies.

The selection board may carry out a Skype interview too, to verify the candidate's skills. In the event of any tie, the younger candidate shall prevail.

### 6. SELECTION BOARD

The Selection Board for the procedure for the comparative assessment of qualifications referred to in the present call for applications is appointed by the Degree Programme Board and consists of the President of the Master Degree Programme in **Cognitive Neuroscience**, and of other three Professors of the Degree Programme.

### 7. RANKINGS

Once the terms for participating in the selections are over, the rankings, in which candidates are placed in descending order of score, are prepared.

The ranking, determined by the score obtained in the evaluation of the curricular requirements, will be published in the course catalogue https://corsidilaurea.uniroma1.it/ on the course page by September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The online list will be published only by serial number, the list of names will be available at the Student Secretariat.

Winning students must enrol by September 25th, 2020 (ALL) or October 16<sup>th</sup> 2020 (students NOT needing a VISA, missing final thesis discussion ONLY).

All the winning students who graduate after the deadline for enrolment will be able to enrol only after having discussed the final test that must be before October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Those who do not enrol by the prescribed date or, only in the case of undergraduates, do not submit a precautionary application to the student administration office, will be considered as renounceses and the vacant positions will be attributed to the following candidates according to the merit ranking. A similar procedure must be followed by undergraduate students returning to the first and second place.

In this regard, subsequent lists of incoming students will be published with the following deadline schedule:

October 23rd, 2020	enrolment deadline for third-time entrants

### 8. ENROLMENT

Enrolment procedures vary according to the different types of students (see below).

Enrolment is obtained by paying the first instalment (if due) of the university enrolment fees for the academic year 2020-2021 to which must be added the regional tax (if due) and stamp duty.

On the dedicated page of the University's website you can find information on the amounts, facilities, terms of presentation of ISEE 2020 and payment methods for bulletins: https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/tasse-contributi.

Italian and foreign students who do not have a tax residence in Italy or who declare income abroad pay a fixed amount. The amounts, differentiated by developing and non-developing countries as well as further information and updates can be found at <a href="https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/tasse-contributi">https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/tasse-contributi</a>.

Contributions must be paid at any agency of the Unicredit Group on the national territory or online with payment by **credit card** (for further information on payment methods consult the web page <a href="https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/come-pagare">https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/come-pagare</a>) on the due date, online payment must be made by 8.30 p.m..

The enrolment form must also indicate the code corresponding to the degree course, which is the same as the one indicated in this announcement and used for participation in the comparative evaluation procedure: **29388**.

Winners holding an **Italian qualification** must make the payment for enrolment, within the deadlines set out in point 7, using the personalized form to be printed from the page https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/infostud-immatricolazione and following the appropriate instructions.

Winners holding a **foreign qualification** for enrolment must go to (or set up a telematic meeting) the Hello - Foreign Students Sector, headquarters of Palazzina dei Servizi Generali Scala C - 2nd floor (see article 10) for the presentation of the **mandatory** documentation within the deadlines set out in point 7:

- Original and photocopy of a valid identity document (for everyone);
- Original and photocopy of the entry visa issued by the Italian Representation of last residence or the receipt of the visa application; original and photocopy of the receipt of the application for residence permit (only for non-EU citizens resident abroad and applicants for study visa);
- Original and photocopy of the residence permit (only for non-EU students legally residing in Italy);
- Original and photocopy of the high school diploma (obtained after at least 12 years of schooling) translated legalized and accompanied by the declaration of value issued by the Italian representation in the country to which the title refers or the Certificates of Comparability and Verification issued by CIMEA (http://www.cimea.it/it/index.aspx);
- Original and photocopy of the university degree (obtained at the end of at least 15 years of study, of which at least the last 3 are university students), translated legalized and accompanied by the declaration of value issued by the Italian representation in the country to which the degree refers or the Certificates of Comparability and Verification issued by CIMEA (http://www.cimea.it/it/index.aspx);
- Examination certificate issued by the university translated and legalized or accompanied by the Certificate of Verification issued by CIMEA (http://www.cimea.it/it/index.aspx);

**Attention:** If the degree obtained during the BA is awarded in English, translation into Italian will not be necessary, but legalization will be compulsory. The declaration of value or the Certificate of Comparability of the university degree can be replaced by the Diploma Supplement for which translation into Italian will not be necessary, but legalization will be compulsory.

In compliance with the provisions issued by the competent authorities in relation to the Coronavirus Emergency, the registration procedures, such as: completion, presentation and administrative control of the mandatory documents will also be carried out electronically.

Please note that non-EU citizens permanently residing abroad who apply for a study visa, before starting the procedure indicated in this call for applications, must make a **mandatory** prescription on the UNIVERSITALY platform https://www.universitaly.it/ and contact the foreign students sector "Hello-foreign students office" at the dedicated email: accesso.sapienza@uniroma1.it. Provisions in force for the a.y. 2020-2021: https://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/. For any further information regarding the foreign study path, please contact studentistranieri@uniroma1.it.

Within the deadlines set out in point 7 winners must make the payment by printing the bulletin from the page https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/infostud-immatricolazione and following the appropriate instructions.

Winners enrolled in another Sapienza Degree Course must submit an application for transfer to the Student Secretariat of the course they belong to, make a payment of € 65,00 (with the exception of transfers made in the year of enrolment 2020-2021 in the absence of a career), as reimbursement of transfer expenses, and also make, within the deadlines set out in point 7, the payment of the first installment of contributions for the new course to be collected from the Student Secretariat of Medicine and Psychology (see point 10).

**Please note:** after the payment of the reimbursement of the passage expenses, it will no longer be possible to take the exams for the degree course of origin.

Winners already enrolled at other Italian Universities must apply for a transfer to the University of origin, submit an application for transfer, pay the first instalment of the registration fees by the deadline specified in point 7, downloading the bulletin from the page https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/infostud-immatricolazione, and pay € 65,00 as reimbursement of transfer expenses. The bulletin for the reimbursement of transfer expenses will be downloadable from Infostud from January 2021.

**Please note**: once the transfer application has been submitted, it will no longer be possible to take the exams for the degree course of origin.

Winners holding of a foreign academic title who wish to apply for a course abbreviation or recognition of university exams obtained after the BA acquired abroad must submit, within the deadlines set out in point 7, to the Hello - Foreign Students Sector in addition to the documentation indicated, a request on paper made legal by affixing a revenue stamp of € 16.00 accompanied by:

- Original and photocopy of the university degree, translated legalized and accompanied by the declaration of value issued by the Italian representation in the country to which the degree refers or the Certificates of Comparability and Verification issued by CIMEA (http://www.cimea.it/it/index.aspx);

- Original and photocopy of the exam certificate issued by the university, translated and legalized or accompanied by the Certificate of Verification issued by CIMEA (http://www.cimea.it/it/index.aspx);
- Original and photocopy of the detailed syllabuses for each single discipline, indicating the hours of teaching and theoretical-practical activity required to obtain the foreign qualification, stamped with the original University stamp and translated into Italian. A sworn translation is not necessary for this document.

In compliance with the provisions issued by the competent authorities in relation to the Coronavirus Emergency, the enrolment procedures, such as: completion, presentation and administrative control of the compulsory documents will also be carried out in telematic mode. Since this is a Master's degree course is held exclusively in English, if the degree presented and the related programmes have been issued in English, there will be no need for translation into Italian.

### 9. Withdrawal procedure after enrolment

Students who, after having enrolled, wish to withdraw from enrolment from the degree programme must go to the Student Affairs Office and submit a written declaration on stamp-impressed paper or on plain paper with a € 16,00 revenue stamp on it.

Students who withdraw from enrolment have no right to receive a refund for the tuition fees they have already paid.

### Data processing purposes

The processing of the required personal data is performed to determine the score, corresponding to each univocal identification barcode, achieved by candidates in the admission tests for degree programmes.

Admission tests are ruled by Article 4, subsection 1, of law 2 August 1999, No. 264 containing regulations on degree programmes access, that ratifies, in Article 2, the motivations for which Universities may autonomously decide to limit the number of admissions to degree programmes.

### Methods of processing and data subjects

The personal data processing is run, following a computerized procedure, by units of the staff designated by the InfoSapienza ICT Area of "Sapienza University".

The subjects appointed receive, in separate boxes and from members in charge of the supervision, the candidates' test papers marked with a univocal identification code and the candidate data sheets so that they may match, after the automatic correction of the answers, the results with the candidates and, consequently, prepare the ranking with the candidates data.

### Nature of personal data conferral and consequences of a possible refusal

Giving the personal data, indicated in the candidate data sheet that is kept by the University at the end of each admission test, is obligatory in order to match the identification code/student/score achieved that allows the ranking preparation. Failure to obtain these data results in the invalidation of the test.

#### Data processing controller

The data processing controller is the Rector of "Sapienza University of Rome", in his/her role of legal representative.

### Rights referred to in Article 7 of the D.lgs 196/2003 (Right to access personal data and other rights)

- 1. Data subjects have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning them exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
- 2. Data subjects have the right to be informed:
- a) of the source of the personal data;
- b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
- c) of the logic applied to the processing in the case of data processing carried out with the aid of electronic tools;
- d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated by virtue of Article 5, subsection 2;

- c) certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.
- 4. Data subjects have the right to object, in whole or in part:
- a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning them, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection
- b) to the processing of personal data concerning them, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.
