The European School Network was established in 2006 by three founding members (Humboldt University of Berlin, King's College London, and University Paris II Panthéon-Assas) in order to develop a European Lawyer programme (Juriste Européen). Sapienza University and the University of Amsterdam have become members of this prestigious programme respectively in 2012 and in 2014.

Students who join this programme pursue undergraduate studies at their home institution for three years and then spend two years at two of the five partner universities (one year in each institution), obtaining from each university a master's degree.

The central aim of the course of study is to enable students to get a deeper knowledge and understanding of different legal systems in Europe and of EU Law in general.
