



EXAM GUIDELINES

Last updated on 02/12/2020

The final exam consists of two parts: a video project and a written exam.

- **PART 1:**

The project work will be based on TedTalk and students will be allowed to choose their preferred topic in the field of Cooperation, Culture, Global Development, Global Issues and Sociology. The project must include a 120 words summary and a 5-minute video presentation. Students must submit their projects 15 days before the exam date.

There are 30 points available for the project.

- **PART 2:**

The written exam lasts 20 minutes. There will be two gap fill exercises.

There are 30 points available, 15 points for each exercise.

The written exam will take place online with the platform **Exam.net**.

The final mark will be either Pass or Fail. To pass the exam candidates must achieve 18 points in the written exam and 18 points in the project work.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PART 1:

1. Choose one TedTalk (<https://www.ted.com/topics>) among the topics listed below:
 - a. Cooperation
 - b. Culture
 - c. Global Development
 - d. Global Issues
 - e. Sociology

2. Prepare a 3-5 minute video presentation about the TedTalk you've chosen. In your video presentation, you must include the following:
 - a. Name of speaker and title of TedTalk
 - b. What is the talk about
 - c. Why did you chose this talk
 - d. What did you learn from this talk
 - e. Why would you recommend this talk

IMPORTANT: your video must last a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes.

No less no more.

3. Write a 120 words summary of your video presentation. In your summary you must include:
 - a. Name of speaker and title
 - b. Link to the TedTalk

IMPORTANT: your summary must have a minimum of 100 words and a maximum of 120 words. **No less no more.**

There are 30 points available for Part 1. Students must achieve 18 points to pass PART 1. Please see below the assessment criteria and points.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR VIDEO AND SUMMARY:

- ❖ You must submit your video and summary via Google Classroom only.
- ❖ You must name your files (PDF file and video file) following this format:

- ❖ Your summary must follow the format below:
 - PDF document
 - Characters allowed: Arial, Times New Roman or Calibri
 - Character size: 12
 - Spacing 1.5
 - Colour: black
- ❖ All files must be submitted on Google Classroom
