Admission methods for the Master's Degree with entry requirements and academic knowledge assessment in:

1. Stages of the procedure

For admission to the master's degree, it is required to:

- a. **Pay** the €10,00 fee in compliance with the methods and deadlines indicated in section 3.
- b. **Wait for the outcome** of the entry requirements assessment. **If the requirements are not met**, it is possible to acquire the missing credits by passing single exams. The methods and costs are set out in "*Single Exams*" of the Student Regulations [Go to the Student Regulations](#)
- c. **Carry out the academic knowledge assessment** in the modalities indicated in section 4.
- d. **Proceed to enrolment** by paying the master's degree enrolment tuition fees in accordance with the procedures and deadlines indicated in section 5. Enrolment can only take place when the Student Affairs Office sends an email notification of the successful outcome of entry requirements and academic knowledge assessment.

For candidates from other Italian universities

Applicants from other Italian universities, after paying the €10,00 fee, must submit a self-certification indicating the exams taken, the scientific disciplines corresponding to the subjects, and relating syllabuses using the form "Dichiarazione laurea ed esami" available on the University Website at the student forms page <https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/student-forms>. Submissions must be made in one of the following ways:

- from the email address indicated on Infostud at the time of registration to the email address of your Student Affairs Office or the address indicated in the curricular requirements, available in the Course Catalogue, on the page of each degree programme, in the Enrolment section. Before submitting your application, you must check that you have uploaded your identification document on Infostud, under the section "Profile>Personal documents";
- from your personal certified e-mail address to the Sapienza University of Rome certified e-mail address protocollosapienza@cert.uniroma1.it

For candidates who have not graduated yet

If the programme regulations provide for it, candidates who have not yet graduated (from Sapienza University of Rome or other universities) may also apply for entry requirements assessment, without prejudice to the obligation to graduate by January 24, 2026 (for those who have not yet graduated from Sapienza University of Rome) and by December 20, 2025 (for those who have not yet graduated from other Italian and international universities).

For candidates from foreign countries and/or with an educational qualification obtained in a non-Italian education system

Procedures for candidates coming from foreign countries are indicated in section 6.

2. Entry requirements

Based on the current regulations in force and having taken into consideration the study plans in foreign locations that have shown interest in the present Master's Degree, the following entry requirements are requested:

Bachelor of Arts or equivalent qualification obtained abroad, or Bachelor's Degree obtained in Italy, provided that the conditions listed below are implemented:

For those who have not obtained a Bachelor's degree or equivalent in Italy, the assessment of the entry requirements may not be conducted with reference to the scientific-disciplinary sectors listed below (which are not always replicable outside the Italian context), but based on an overall assessment that attests to the solidity of previous knowledge in the fields of art history and classical archaeology. In this regard, if it is deemed necessary, it is possible to have a remote interview with the interested parties.

- at least 30 ECTS for students coming from three-year degree programmes in Italy (3 exams for four-year degree programmes) in the scientific-disciplinary sectors listed below:

L-ANT/01 Prehistory and Protohistory; L-ANT/04 Numismatics; L-ANT/06 Etruscology and Italic antiquities; L-ANT/07 Classical Archaeology; L-ANT/08 Christian and Medieval Archaeology; L-ANT/09 Ancient topography; L-ANT/10 Archaeological research methodologies; L-OR/02 Egyptology and Coptic civilisation; L-OR/03 Assyriology; L-OR/04 Anatolistics; L-OR/05 Ancient Near Eastern archaeology and art history; L-OR/06 Phoenician-Punic Archaeology; L-OR/11 Archaeology and history of Muslim art; L-OR/16 Archaeology and art history of India and Central Asia; L-OR/20 Archaeology, art history and philosophies of East Asia;

- and at least 60 ECTS (5 exams for 4-year degrees) from the scientific-disciplinary sectors listed below:

L-ANT/01 to L-ANT/10; L-ART/01, L-ART/04; L-FIL-LET/01 to L-FIL-LET/12; L-LIN/01; L-OR/01 to L-OR/18; L-OR/20 to L-OR/23; M-DEA/01, M-GGR/01, M-GGR/02; M-STO/01, M-STO/06 to M-STO/09; BIO/01 to BIO/05, BIO/07, BIO/08, BIO/10; CHIM/01 to CHIM/06, CHIM/12, FIS/07; GEO/01, GEO/02, GEO/04, GEO/07, GEO/08, GEO/09, GEO/11; ICAR/06, ICAR/15, ICAR/17, ICAR/18, ICAR/19; ING-INF/05; IUS/01, IUS/09, IUS/10, IUS/14; SPS/05, SPS/13, SPS/14.

In all cases, particularly for non-native speakers of English, a fluent knowledge of English corresponding to at least level B2 is a prerequisite for admission to the Master's Degree in Mediterranean Archaeology.

3. Entry requirements assessment

The assessment of entry requirements is requested by paying a fee of €10,00 from July 2, 2025 to one of the following dates of your choice:

- September 16, 2025 (only date available for non-EU candidates who request a student visa)
- October 16, 2025
- November 18, 2025
- December 16, 2025

- January 15, 2026 (date reserved for those who have already graduated or are about to graduate from Sapienza University of Rome).

Payment is generated on the Infostud system.

Payment is made online via PagoPA (direct payment).

The code to be entered in the system is **33542**.

The outcome of the entry requirements assessment will be communicated to the institutional mailbox (if activated) or to the personal email address declared on Infostud

4. Academic knowledge assessment

Admission to the Master's Degree Programme is subject, in addition to the fulfilment of the pre-determined curricular requirements, to the passing of an assessment of the adequacy of academic knowledge and language skills, which will take place through the assessment of the degree grade, qualifications, curriculum and, if necessary, of the effective individual skills, which may be determined through a personal test or interview.

6. For candidates with an educational qualification obtained within a non-Italian education system

For those with citizenship in non-EU countries, residing abroad and applying for a study visa, and for those from China and participating in the Marco Polo project
