## 1. Stages of the procedure

For admission to the master's degree, it is required to:

- a. **Pay** the €10,00 fee in compliance with the methods and deadlines indicated in section 3.
- b. **Wait for the outcome** of the entry requirements assessment. **If the requirements are not met**, it is possible to acquire the missing credits by passing single exams. The methods and costs are set out in "*Single Courses*" of the Student Regulations [Go to the Student Regulations](#)
- c. **Carry out the academic knowledge assessment** in the modalities indicated in section 4.
- d. **Proceed to enrolment** by paying the master's degree enrolment tuition fees in accordance with the procedures and deadlines indicated in section 5. Enrolment can only take place when the Student Affairs Office sends an email notification of the successful outcome of the entry requirements and academic knowledge assessment.

### For candidates from other Italian universities

Applicants from other Italian universities, after paying the €10,00 fee, must submit a self-certification indicating the exams taken, the scientific disciplines corresponding to the subjects, and relating syllabuses using the form "*Dichiarazione laurea ed esami*" available on the University Website at the student forms page <https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/student-forms>. Submissions must be made in one of the following ways:

- from the email address indicated on Infostud at the time of registration to the email address of your Student Affairs Office or the address indicated in the curricular requirements, available in the Course Catalogue, on the page of each degree programme, in the Enrolment section. Before submitting your application, you must check that you have uploaded your identification document on Infostud, under the section "Profile>Personal documents";

### **For candidates who have not graduated yet**

If the programme regulations provide for it, candidates who have not yet graduated (from Sapienza University of Rome or other universities) may also apply for entry requirements assessment, without prejudice to the obligation to graduate by January 24, 2026 (for those who have not yet graduated from Sapienza University of Rome) and by December 20, 2025 (for those who have not yet graduated from other Italian and international universities).

### **For candidates from foreign countries and/or with an educational qualification obtained in a non-Italian education system**

Procedures for candidates coming from foreign countries are indicated in section 6.

## **2. Entry requirements**

Admission to the Master's Degree Programme is open to anyone holding a Bachelor's degree, or a three-year university degree, or another qualification acquired abroad and recognised as suitable, provided that they have obtained 84 ECTS in the following scientific-disciplinary sectors:

Of the 84 ECTS mentioned above, at least 54 must be in the Scientific-Disciplinary Sectors (SSDs): ANGL-01/A (L-LIN/10), ANGL-01/B (L-LIN/11), ANGL-01/C (L-LIN/12), with at least 24 ECTS in ANGL-01/C (L-LIN/12) (three years, level C1.1, requirement deemed fulfilled if the language of delivery of the whole degree programme is English); and with at least 6 ECTS in ANGL-01/A (L-LIN/10) or ANGL-01/B (L-LIN/11).

Admission is also open to holders of a degree obtained under the old academic system who have taken 5 exams in English or Anglo-American language and literature, and 2 exams in the literary or linguistic-philological disciplines.

A C1.1 level of English is required for admission to the degree programme.

Proficiency (level B1) in Italian is also required.

### 3. Entry requirements assessment

The assessment of entry requirements is requested by paying a fee of €10,00 from July 2, 2025 to one of the following dates of your choice:

- September 16, 2025 (only date available for non-EU candidates who request a student visa)
- October 16, 2025
- November 18, 2025
- December 16, 2025
- January 15, 2026 (date reserved for those who have already graduated or are about to graduate from Sapienza University of Rome).

**The outcome** of the entry requirements assessment will be communicated to the institutional mailbox (if activated) or to the personal email address declared on Infostud.

### 4. Academic knowledge assessment

Admission to the Master's Degree also requires an assessment of the adequacy of academic knowledge.

All applicants meeting the curricular requirements and with a Bachelor's degree grade below 100/110 will have to undergo an interview to assess their academic knowledge; applicants with an international degree will be invited to an interview indicated by the Enrolment Committee ("*Commissione enrollment*"). The interview will be conducted online, if necessary. The methods for assessing the adequacy of academic knowledge, which can only be accessed by those who meet the curricular requirements, are contained in the Didactic Regulations, available on the degree programme's website.
