with assessment of entry requirements and personal knowledge in:

Cognitive Forensic Sciences

1. Stages of the procedure

To be admitted to the programme, you must:

- a. **Pay** the fee of €10.00 in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in point 3.
- b. **Wait for the outcome** of the eligibility check. **If you do not meet the entry requirements**, you may acquire the missing credits by passing individual exams. The procedures and costs are set out in the section '*Single Examinations*' of the Regulations for Attendance at Bachelor's and Master's Degree Programmes and for Student Fees

- c. **Carry out the personal skills assessment** in accordance with the procedures set out in point 4.
- d. **Proceed with enrolment** by paying the course enrolment fees in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set out in point 5.
Enrolment can only take place once the Student Affairs Office has sent an email confirming the successful outcome of the eligibility and personal preparation checks.

For students coming from other Italian universities

Students coming from other Italian universities must, after paying the €10.00 fee, submit a self-certification stating the exams taken, the scientific-disciplinary sectors corresponding to the modules, and the relevant syllabuses, using the '*Dichiarazione laurea ed esami per la verifica dei requisiti*' form available on the University website, on the student forms page <https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/student-forms>

The declaration may be submitted using the personal email address provided on Infostud at the time of registration or via a certified email (PEC) address.

- If you are using your personal email address, the address to be entered as the recipient is that of your Student Affairs Office or the address specified in the course requirements, available in the degree programme catalogue on the page for each course, under the 'Enrolment' section. Before submitting your application, you must ensure that you have uploaded your identity document to Infostud under 'Profile > Personal Documents';

- If you are using a certified email (PEC) account, the address to enter as the recipient is protocollosapienza@cert.uniroma1.it

For students who have not yet obtained their degree

Where the course regulations so provide, students who have not yet obtained their degree (at Sapienza or at other universities) may also apply for verification of their eligibility, subject to the requirement to obtain it by 23 January 2027 (for students who have not yet obtained their degree at Sapienza) and by 19 December 2026 (for students who have not yet obtained their degree from other Italian or international universities).

For students from abroad and/or holding a qualification obtained within a foreign education system

The procedures for students from abroad are set out in point 6.

2. Admission requirements

Admission to the Master's degree programme requires a three-year bachelor's degree or university diploma, or another qualification obtained abroad that is recognised as suitable and equivalent.

In addition to the three-year bachelor's degree or university diploma, in line with the multidisciplinary nature of the degree programme, the following is required:

1. at least 40 ECTS credits in one of the following fields or groups of scientific-disciplinary sectors:

- a) AREA 11-PSIC Psychological Sciences (**former SSD:** M/PSI-01, M/PSI-02, M/PSI-03, M/PSI-04, M/PSI-05, M/PSI-06, M/PSI-07, M/PSI-08)
- b) AREA 01-MATH Mathematical Sciences, PHYS-01/A, PHYS-03/A, PHYS-06/A, PHYS-06/B (**former SSD:** MAT/01, MAT/02, MAT/03, MAT/04, MAT/05, MAT/06, MAT/07, MAT/08, MAT/09, FIS/01, FIS/03, FIS/07, FIS/08)
- c) AREA 03-CHEM Chemical Sciences
- d) AREA 05-BIOS Biological Sciences
- e) AREA 06-MEDS Medical Sciences
- f) AREA 12-GIUR Legal Sciences, GSPS-05/A, GSPS-06/A, GSPS-07/B (**former SSD:** SPS/07, SPS/08, SPS/12)

2. Proficiency in English, at least equivalent to level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The procedures for assessing foreign language proficiency are set out in the course's academic regulations.

3. Verification of eligibility

Verification of eligibility must be requested by paying a €10.00 fee from 2 July 2026 and by one of the following dates, as chosen:

- 15 September 2026 (the only applicable date for applicants from non-EU countries requiring a student visa)
- 15 October 2026
- 17 November 2026
- 17 December 2026
- 14 January 2027 (date reserved for those who have already obtained a degree from Sapienza or are about to graduate).

The payment is generated via the Infostud system.

The **payment** is made online via PagoPA (direct payment).

The code to be entered into the system is **33583**.

The result of the eligibility check will be sent to your institutional email account (if active) or to the personal email address provided on Infostud.

4. Assessment of personal knowledge

Personal knowledge will be assessed by evaluating the level of knowledge and understanding of basic statistics and basic research methodology. The assessment procedures are set out in the Course Regulations.

Applicants for the Master's programme are also required to submit a maximum of two letters of recommendation written by lecturers who have had the opportunity to get to know the applicant during their university studies.

The selection committee reserves the right to conduct an oral interview, which may take place remotely, to assess the applicant's skills.

The procedures for assessing the adequacy of personal knowledge, which are open only to those who meet the curricular requirements, are set out in the Course Regulations, available on the programme's website.

5. Enrolment

6. For students who hold a qualification from a foreign education system
