Some exams will be automatically approved. Other exams could be checked and approved by the Segreteria Studenti or the Programme Coordinator.	
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**ELECTIVE COURSE\***: It is an opportunity gave to you to create a more personal curriculum based on your interests linked with the master's degree purposes.

You have different ways to cover these credits. You can choose:

- to take **one exam of 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 credits** (CFU) among all the courses held at the Faculty of Architecture. Check and open a [programme](#), then click on “Attendance” to check the available courses.
- to take **two exams held at the Faculty of Architecture** to cover minimum 8 credits and maximum 12 credits. Check and open a [programme](#), then click on “Attendance” to check the available courses.
- to take **another exam in the 1st optional group** (the 2 remaining credits can be obtained following a laboratory, workshop)
- to **take exams among any other course held at ‘Sapienza’**. In this last case, you must obtain by Committee (or Programme Coordinator) a specific authorization which will be released on behalf of a motivated request. Check and open a [programme](#), then click on “Attendance” to check the available courses
- during your **Erasmus**

### **PERCORSO FORMATIVO (EDUCATIONAL CAREER – TRAINING PATH)**

**1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students must fill out their own training path/study plan (*percorso formativo curriculare*) through Infostud, between 10<sup>th</sup> October and 10<sup>th</sup> November.** It is specially required to choose the optional and elective courses.

Changes are allowed once per year only. You can do it **between 10<sup>th</sup> March and 10<sup>th</sup> April.**

If you do not create your training path you cannot see and book your exams to take. Sometimes it is only possible to book mandatory exams but you cannot book the optional and elective courses.

**Log on Infostud**, click on **CORSI DI LAUREA**, then click on **ENGLISH VERSION** (on the top right side), now click on **EDUCATIONAL CAREER** (on the bottom left side) and click on **GO TO EDUCATIONAL PATH**. **A new window will be open**, you can click on the **SMALL ENGLISH FLAG** (on the top right side), then click on **CAREER PLANNING**. **Now you can see/create/update/save your PERCORSO FORMATIVO**. Select your exams (specially the optionals and electives). You can create more than one training path that you can save as drafts. The system will help you to check the credits and every didactic details. After you are sure about your training path, click on **INVIA**, then **RICHIEDI APPROVAZIONE** and again **INVIA**. You should read:

- “*Il percorso formativo è corretto e può essere approvato automaticamente*” (it means that it is automatically confirmed by the University)
- “*Il percorso formativo è corretto*” (it means that the Segreteria Didattica or the Programme Coordinator will evaluate your request and will approve or ask to modify it).
